

## Stage Makeup Guidelines

ALL Girls	ALL Boys
Eyeliners on top and bottom lids (brown or black)	Eyeliners on top and bottom lids (brown or black)
Blush (be generous, apply on cheek bones for a more feminine look)	Blush (be generous, apply on the center of the cheek instead of on cheekbones, for a more masculine look)
Lip color (You can use lipstick, but please stick with more natural colors, no reds or dark colors. Alternatively you can use a q-tip and blush or a non-shimmer eyeshadow color to color lips)	Natural lip color (you can use a q-tip and blush or a non-shimmer eyeshadow color to color lips)
Mascara	
Optional: Neutral eyeshadow	

Tips for applying make-up on kids:

When applying eyeliner and mascara have child lean against the wall to help them stand more still.

When applying eyeliner and mascara, ask child to close their eyes, or look down, gently pull up on the eyebrow and apply the eyeliner or mascara, with gentle strokes. When applying eyeliner or mascara to the lower lid or lashes, ask the child to look up, and gently pull down on the cheek to apply the makeup.

Red Lipstick
Black eyeliner, more pronounced on the upper lid for a more glamorous look
Mascara
Neutral eyeshadow preferably matte in creases of eye
Light blush
